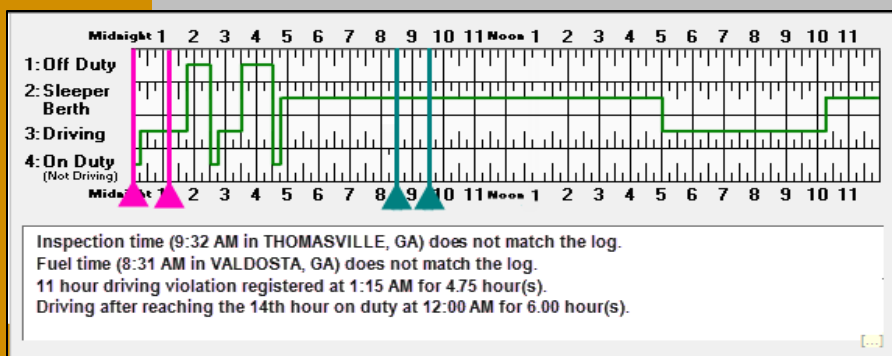
HOURS OF SERVICE

FOR ALL MOTOR AND PASSENGER CARRIERS RAIR's driver log auditing service works with paper logs, log images, and electronic log data. Carriers with paper logs can continue using their existing log forms, which RAIR scans at no additional cost. Audited logs and reports are available within 24-48 hours of receiving the data, and reports are updated in real time.

To verify log accuracy, log data is compared to any form of downloadable electronic data that includes dates and times, such as motor carrier profiles, fuel events, and gate-pass records. RAIR's program includes driver counseling tools, which include automated violation summary reports, automated violations letters, electronic records of counseling sessions, and reports for repeat violations after counseling. DVIR auditing is also included when the DVIR is part of the driver's log.

FOR CARRIERS WITH ELECTRONIC LOGS According to §395.16, motor carriers are required to review their EOBR data for HOS compliance. RAIR assists carriers by verifying log accuracy, comparing log data to supporting documents. RAIR also retains supporting documents' data for the required time period, after which it is destroyed. Contingency plans for EOBR failures combine paper and electronic logs without interrupting HOS compliance history.

FOR CARRIERS IN TRANSITION A single log-in allows motor carriers to track drivers' consecutive hours-of-service, as well as complete HOS history, while combining paper and electronic logs. RAIR's HOS reports integrate both log formats, allowing users to easily distinguish between the two types. This capability helps ease the transition to EOBRs and facilitate driver training.



FOR CARRIERS WITH GPS

RAIR verifies log accuracy by comparing the latitudes and longitudes of GPS data to drivers' log data. The patent-pending, cost-effective system audits 100% of a fleet's logs within minutes with no manual data entry.

DVIRs

RAIR’s automated system audits paper DVIRs for: 1) the identification of defects or a notation that no defects were found, 2) the driver’s signature and 3) a notation that repairs either were made or were unnecessary.

Electronic data is also used to create viewable and printable DVIR images that are customized to meet the needs of each carrier. RAIR audits electronic DVIR data for the presence of defects/no defects, driver IDs, vehicle IDs, dates, and comments. DVIRs are also compared with roadside inspections to determine whether problems were identified on the day of, or the day prior to, an inspection.

DRIVER QUALIFICATIONS

RAIR helps carriers properly maintain their DQ files, while relieving them of the headaches associated with this time-consuming and cumbersome task. An automated auditing and management system helps carriers maintain accurate and complete files, segregate documents to limit exposure during an audit, and eliminate documents when they are no longer needed. All forms required by the DOT are audited for completeness, compliance, expiration dates, and signatures. Electronic data, paper documents, and document images are accepted. RAIR offers automated alerts to inform carriers of expiring documents.

CSA

CSA scores are the tip of the iceberg: they measure violations that have already occurred, but they don’t address violations that will occur in the future if carriers fail to take action.
